

## **Severe Weather Alert: Most M&T Bank Branches Open After Hurricane Sandy**

Depending on local conditions, including the availability of power and telecommunications service, local flooding and travel conditions, the status of our branch network is as follows:

### **NEW YORK CITY/LONG ISLAND**

- All branches open normal business hours with the exception of:
  - Flatiron – 200 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue – New York, NY
  - Gramercy East – 397 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue – New York, NY
  - Madison South – 95 Madison Avenue – New York, NY
  - Oceanside – 12 Atlantic Avenue – Oceanside, NY

### **DELAWARE**

- All branches open normal business hours

### **MARYLAND**

- All branches open normal business hours with the exception of:
  - Bel Air Main – 12 Office Street – Bel Air, MD
  - Deep Creek – 19795 Garrett Highway – Garrett, MD
  - Grantsville – 124 Main Street – Garrett, MD
  - Oakland – 46 South Second Street – Garrett, MD

### **WASHINGTON DC**

- All branches open normal business hours

### **VIRGINIA**

- All branches open normal business hours

### **WEST VIRGINIA**

- All branches open normal business hours

### **PENNSYLVANIA**

- All branches open normal business hours with the exception of:
