

## M&T Announces Winners of the Baltimore Small Business Accelerator Program

*Brian Dawkins awarded \$5,000 grand prize to support From Baltimore With Love*

**Baltimore, MD, Oct. 29, 2025** — Brian Dawkins, founder of From Baltimore With Love, was awarded the \$5,000 grand prize in the small business accelerator pitch competition hosted by M&T Bank (NYSE: MTB). This program aims to equip entrepreneurs with essential skills and guidance to build resilient businesses, drive economic growth in Baltimore, and create generational wealth for their families.

From Baltimore With Love (FBWL) is a creative brand dedicated to celebrating Baltimore through authentic storytelling, apparel, and community initiatives. The competition was the culmination of a seven-week program launched on September 9, covering topics such as business planning, capital sourcing, financial management, marketing, and branding. The program concluded on October 28 with a pitch competition, followed by the announcement of awards, funded by M&T Bank.

Courtney Roberts of Cure Medspa and Wellness won the second-place prize of \$3,000, and Amber Washington of London's Bright Beginnings won the third-place prize of \$2,000.

To qualify, businesses had to be based in Baltimore, in operation for at least two years, and in good standing. M&T Bank also offers similar accelerator programs in Montgomery, Howard, Frederick, and Prince George's counties.
